Companies are excluded from the index according to the following EIRIS criteria and thresholds, as defined by Think ETF Asset Management:

Adult entertainment/pornography

Companies who derive 3% or more of their turnover from adult entertainment services

Alcohol

Companies who derive 5% or more of their turnover from alcohol production

Animal testing

- Companies who provide animal testing services
- ➤ Companies who derive 3% or more of their turnover from the manufacture of cosmetics intermediates tested on animals

Controversial weapons

- Companies whose products or services constitute whole or strategic parts for nuclear weapons systems
- Companies for which EIRIS has found clear evidence of involvement in the production of cluster munitions systems, or the production of key parts of, or the provision of services for cluster munitions
- Companies who have not addressed allegations of involvement with antipersonnel landmines
- Companies linked to the manufacture of chemical or biological weapons

Firearms

- Companies who derive any turnover from the manufacture or sale of firearms or related products
- Companies who derive any turnover from the manufacture or sale of civilian firearms or related products

Gambling

Companies who derive 5% or more of their turnover from gambling

• Genetic engineering

- Companies who genetically engineer crops
- Companies who genetically engineer animals

• Hazardous chemicals

Companies who manufacture chemicals of concern, internationally restricted chemicals or chemicals subject to NGO campaigns

Intensive farming

Companies who derive any turnover from intensive pig or poultry farming

Nuclear

Companies who own or operate nuclear power stations

Military production and sale

Whole weapons systems

• Production of fur

Companies who sell fur products

Tobacco

Companies who derive any turnover from tobacco production

Violations of UN Global Compact principles

- Companies who have not adequately addressed allegations of breaches of
 - international human rights principles
 - Core ILO (International Labour Organisation) standards on child labour, forced labour, discrimination and freedom of association
 - Anti-bribery principles
 - Environmental standards
